In Luke 10:25-29, in response to a lawyer's question about loving his neighbor, Jesus taught his followers the parable of the Good Samaritan. Like the unselfish Samaritan man, we Christians are called to extend our love and concern to all persons everywhere, as our neighbors. We commonly think of neighbors as the people who live near us, but Jesus meant it to include all mankind! Excluding anyone or any group because of social status, marital status, a supposed character fault, or even religious, racial, or ethnic differences is not acceptable to Him. God loves them all... And so should we!!

According to the Census Bureau, over 43% of American adults (over age 18) were either single or single again in 2009. Wow! So one could conclude that many of our "neighbors" are single adults!! This steep increase in our single adult population is due to several factors, which include climbing divorce rates and singles waiting to marry later in life. These trends have made the single-adult population in the U.S. soar to a number of about 96 million strong! This population is too vast to ignore!

So who are our "neighbor" single adults? First and foremost, single adults are just that – Adults. They cover a wide age range as well as have varying lifestyles. They have completed various levels of education and occupy all levels of income. Some have stressful jobs that require advanced skills and thought. Some have children and grandchildren, some care for elderly parents. Single adults are a vital part of our church! Several teach our children in Sunday school. They are active in our choir, in our children's church and youth ministries, and have also coached bible quizzing. They are hostesses and ushers, and are involved in our women's and men's ministries. But there are some who have very little involvement in church activities, who often come to our churches frustrated, confused, and overwhelmed with what life has thrown at them. Our culture's emphasis on what is considered the normal family unit has often made it easy for the single adult to feel left out or not worthy to be involved in ministry.

How are we reaching out to single adults? SALT (Single Adults Living Truth) – "A Ministry to Singles" is our new singles ministry at FPCDS!! Within this ministry, we are targeting single adults, ages 30s to 50s, who desire to strengthen their relationship with God while also becoming a part of a community of support and fellowship. Our purpose is to form relationships that motivate and promote spiritual and social growth, and to help our single adults to understand, live, and demonstrate the purpose of the New Testament church in today's world.

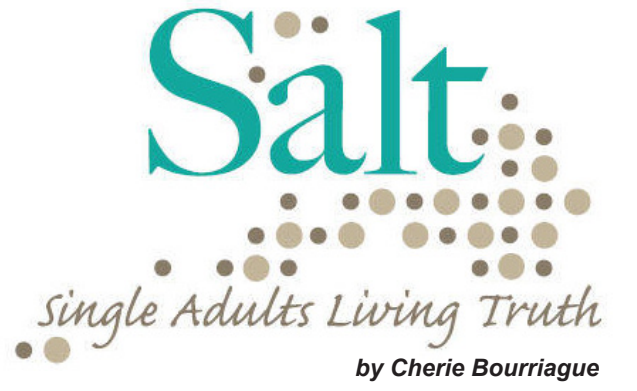
God Himself created and established the church. Paul referred to it as the body of Christ, of which Christ Himself is the Head. Since the church is a divine institution with a divine origin, only God determines its purpose. The New Testament gives numerous insights into this purpose; however, the purpose of the Apostolic church can be well summarized in these few key paraphrased passages:

Matthew 22:37-40: ...Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind...Love your neighbor as yourself...

Acts 2: 42: And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

Acts 1:8: Ye shall receive power... and ye shall be witnesses unto me...unto the uttermost part of the earth.

SALT is about Worship thru Ministry...
 ...Worship is vertical: "Love the Lord your God..." It focuses on how we relate to God. He wants our worship to be a lifestyle of

submission to His will. He wants us to worship by being a reflection of His love, which involves ministry. We do this through relationships that attract others to the Savior by real, open, and authentic Christ-like living. Ministry is horizontal: "Love your neighbor as yourself..." It focuses on how we relate to those around us. Our singles ministry is not just a ministry to singles, but a ministry by singles. Real relationships minister by serving the needs of others, whether physical, emotional, or spiritual. We accomplish this by reaching beyond our personal likes and dislikes, beyond our own comfort zones, and strategically seeking to look after the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of others while impacting lives for Christ.

SALT is uniting through Fellowship...
 ...Just to be clear, our goal for this ministry is not to be matchmakers, but it is about developing quality relationships and encouraging others in the Lord. It is about breaking of bread, prayer, being known and cared for, being held accountable and encouraged on our spiritual journey. We will promote fellowship through activities and events such as game nights, barbeques, dinner events, Sunday nights "Out to Eat", day trips, or conferences. We will encourage fellowship with all groups of our church. We plan to integrate quarterly outings of fellowship and/or outreach with our College/ Career and Young Marrieds. We believe the idea of church not only to be a place to develop a relationship with God, but also with the Body of Christ (our Church family).

SALT is about Discipleship...
 ...Discipleship is about being a Godly example, and learning "truth" together. We will provide a climate for spiritual growth for our single adults which encourages the uncommitted singles to consecrate themselves to God's plan for their life through mentoring and discipleship. Real relationships foster spiritual growth by helping to guide each other into better, more mature relationships with Jesus. We plan to incorporate "Prayer and Share" nights to enable our singles to unite together in seeking a deeper walk with God.

SALT is about Outreach...
 ...Reaching out to others is about being a witness. It is reaching out to our communities with service. It is caring. A growing revival church believes that single adults are crucial players in today's revival. It realizes that the talents and abilities of today's single adults are too valuable to ignore. Single adults are a large, growing, mighty force which can be very instrumental in God's purpose for the church. What a better example to follow than the greatest single adult ever to live – Jesus Christ!!
